

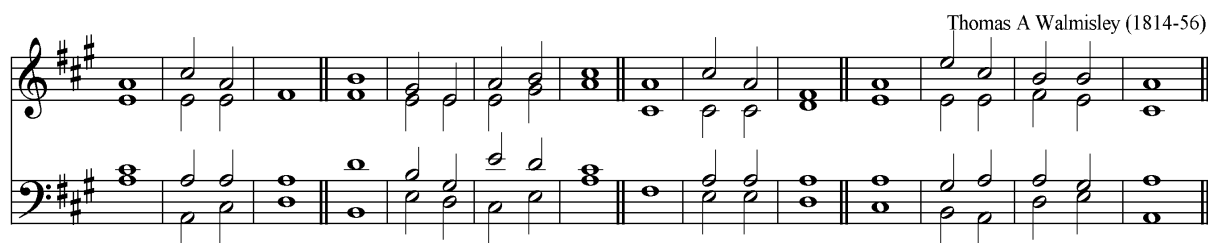

and there is nothing | hidden | from its | heat.

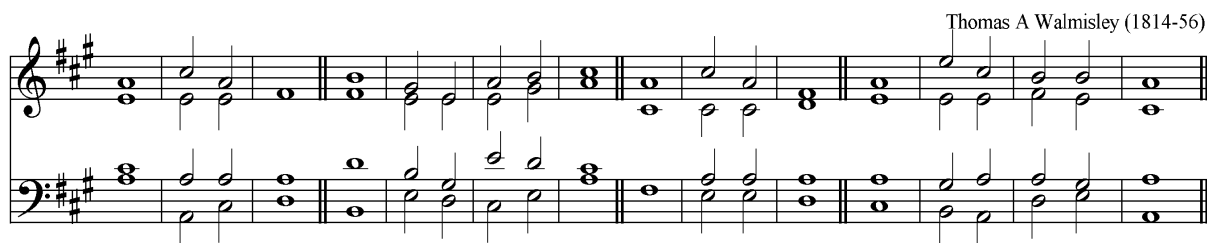
