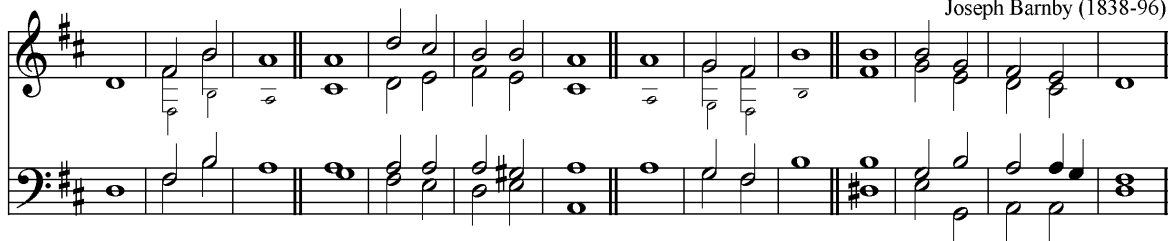

then will Jacob re | joice and | Israel be | glad.

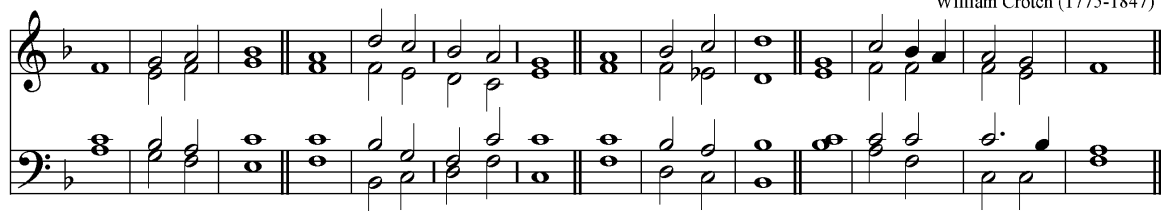
