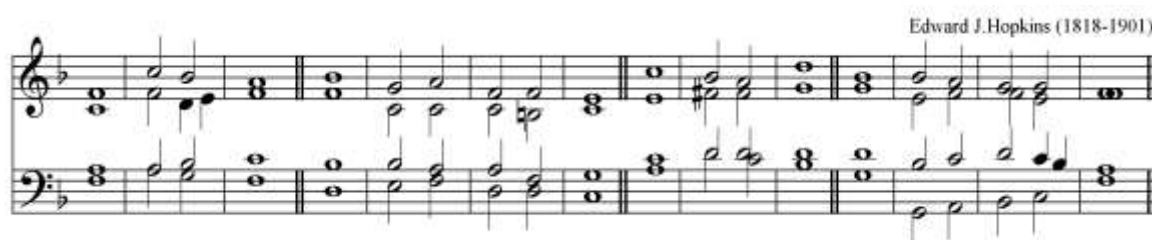

blessed are those who | put their | trust in | you.

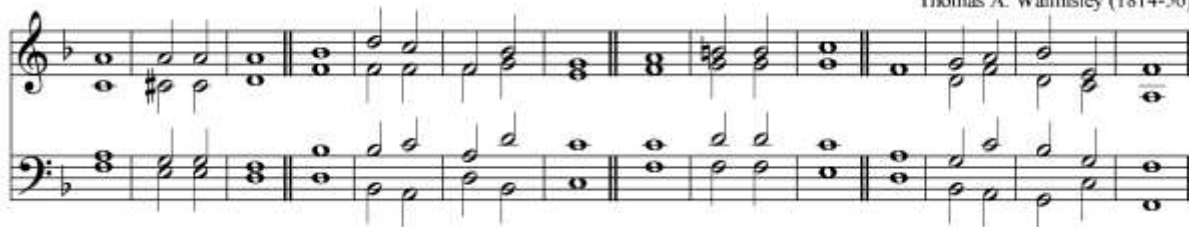
